EXCHANGE RATE sped to the early lead and angled in, led throughout and won clear under a steady hand ride. COLDWATER CANYON, stalked off the rail on the backstretch, angled in for the turn, came out in upper stretch and was second best. SEVENTEEN CANDLES sent four wide between rivals, continued outside the runner-up on the turn and just held third. CAPTIAN BELL, also sent between foes, dropped back on the turn then just missed the show. JOOPY DOOPY saved ground to the stretch, came out and lacked the needed rally. CAPTAIN STEVE, unhurried inside early, came out on the turn and failed to menace. STAYTON, sent along five wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, weakened. TRULY BELIEVE, outside CAPTAIN STEVE on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, did not rally. HERB'S BIRTHDAY, raced a bit off the rail and was outrun.
