MAZEL TRICK, climbing off the rail early, moved up inside on the turn, swung three deep into the stretch, swept to the front in midstretch and drew off under a couple taps of the whip. CHRISTMAS BOY, dueled inside on the backstretch and between horses into the turn, battled outside EXPRESSIONIST on the bend and into the stretch, was no match for the winner but best of the rest. REGAL THUNDER, settled outside, dropped back some into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. EXPRESSIONIST, angled in early, went up inside to a short lead into the turn, battled along the rail until nearing midstretch, then weakened. MEN'S EXCLUSIVE, vied for command three deep on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, dropped back, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. RAY OF SUNSHINE (IRE) settled off the rail, angled in for the turn and did not rally. KAHAL (GB) broke slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. MUSAFI, dueled between horses to the turn and steadily gave way.
