YAZOR went up inside to duel for the lead, kicked clear into the turn, drew off then held under urging. CRYPTOSCRIPT unhurried off the rail early, angled in on the backstretch, began to advance inside on the turn, swung three deep into the stretch and closed the gap to the winner while narrowly edging a rival for second. BADINAGE settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, split horses in deep stretch and just missed the place. CRAFTY MADNESS close up four wide early, stalked outside, went four wide again on the turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. WEHO off a bit slowly, settled inside, swung out into the stretch and improved position. PRETTY MEADOW had speed three deep then stalked off the rail, split horses early on the turn, angled in outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. ALPHABET SONG unhurried off the rail early, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground inching forward on the turn but also weakened. SPEED TO SPEED dueled between horses then outside the winner, dropped back leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch. TENDER TRAP bobbled just after the start and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start but made change when they ruled TENDER TRAP was the cause of her own trouble.
