### Footnotes

WHY KNOTT ME TOO three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the backstretch, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and inched clear in the final furlong under urging. MAJORESSY sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, fought back in upper and midstretch but could not match the winner late while clearly second best. MARYNEILL broke a bit slowly, came off the rail early, chased outside a rival then three deep midway on the backstretch, continued outside a foe on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and picked up the show. MARTIKA TIANNA chased inside, split horses on the backstretch, angled back in on the second turn and did not rally. ONE FUN CAT pulled between foes early, stalked along the inside, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
