FISHIN WITH T BALL sped to the early lead, opened a clear advantage on the backstretch, set the pace inside, drifted out under left handed pressured in the stretch then just held under right handed urging late. LA NEZ wide early, stalked the pace outside, came three deep into the stretch and rallied to just miss. CHATTY LULA stalked outside on the backstretch and three deep midway on the turn, came out into the stretch, angled inward in deep stretch and bested the rest. URA STAR chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S SKATER a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out on the turn and around a rival into the stretch and was not a threat. FREQUENT FAME chased a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. COOL PRINCESS wide early,

chased outside foes, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. ANN'S SEVEN broke in and bumped a rival, stalked the pace off the rail, was between foes midway on the turn, continued a bit off the rail and weakened in the final furlong. AVRIL IN PARIS bumped at the start, settled off the pace three deep then out from the inside and failed to menace. BOOKDMYOCEANCRUISE broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a factor. RIGHT TO WORK also broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace and was outrun.
