PICTURAL forced the early issue, dropped back bit then re-rallied around the turn, bid three wide into the lane, reached the front, then edged away and safely held. CANDY PULL broke out a bit, prompted the pace from the outside, chased three wide, loomed outside winner around the bend and into the stretch but could not match that rival. SAXOPHONE settled outside, chased four wide into and around the bend, awaited room entering the stretch, shifted out and bested others. DR. J J chased outside rival, remained on same path, awaited room on the turn, later came in bit and was outfinished for third. CALL TRANSFER saved ground chasing the pace, was two wide exiting the turn and improved placing. SYNDICATOR reserved from the inside, remained along the rail entering the stretch, came out some but was no threat. WARREN'S OPERATOR prominently placed from the inside, tracked the leaders into the stretch but gave way readily. GO FLAGS BRO flashed good early speed inside, padded cushion into the turn but was collared later on the turn and weakened. SHAKE AND ROLL was off a bit slow then checked off heels, lagged back off the rail and never menaced. OLD THAMESIAN was slow into stride, saved ground but was outrun throughout.
