RE VOTE settled outside a rival, went up four wide leaving the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away and held on gamely under urging. GLITTERING AFFAIR saved ground off the early pace, moved up between foes leaving the backstretch then outside a rival early on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch to loom a threat but was only slowly gaining. THE DR. IS A LADY saved ground toward the inside chasing the leaders, came out leaving the second turn, split horses in midstretch and picked up the show. TWO FOUR DANCER chased toward the inside, bid between horses leaving the backstretch, dueled between rivals on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. BERTHA'S BIKINI had good early speed and dueled on a short lead along the inside and also weakened in the stretch. MISS BANK ROBIN forced the pace outside a rival then three deep into and early on the second turn, dropped back on that bend and gave way.
