Footnotes

SPITFIRE MAN went up between horses early, angled in and dueled inside, inched away past midstretch and proved best under some urging steady handling. TASTE OF PARADISE sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside the winner until just past midstretch, could not match that one late but was clearly second best. SPIRIT O' WAR sent along inside on the backstretch, came out on the turn and into the stretch and gained the show late. HOLT close up stalking the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and weakened. PARK THIS chased between horses then outside on the backstretch, continued alongside a rival on the turn, also came out in upper stretch and weakened. WIN JOLLEY was in a good position tracking the leaders between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, was shuffled back early on the bend, angled in late and also weakened. SYNCOPATED SLEW chased outside early and three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. TOP VENTURE sent between horses early, pulled while dropping back off the rail on the backstretch and was outrun.
