### Footnotes

LAVA MAN stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up into and on the second turn, battled under urging in midstretch then gamely but narrowly prevailed in the final strides under strong handling. A. P. XCELLENT sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, fought back gamely through a long, hard drive and continued willingly to the wire. BIG BOOSTER chased outside then split horses leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished with interest outside the top pair. PORFIDO (CHI) saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in the lane and earned a share of fourth. MOLENGAO (BRZ) a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail, advanced four wide a half mile out, continued three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. A. P. ARROW three deep early, stalked outside a rival then between horses on the second turn and weakened. SAINT STEPHEN a bit fractious in the gate, saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back some on the second turn and also weakened. WILKO stalked the early pace off the rail then angled to the inside on the first turn, tracked the leader along the fence and could not offer the necessary response in the drive. MY CREED settled inside then went between horses on the backstretch and outside a foe on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
