Footnotes

DOUBLE TROUBLE (BRZ) pulled between horses then along the inside stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and waited briefly off heels then bid between foes to gain the lead and held under a left handed crack of the whip and good handling. SWEET BELLE angled in and stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch, bid four wide past midstretch and went willingly to the wire. KRIS' SIS saved ground stalking the pace, waited leaving the second turn, was blocked when boxed in passing the eighth pole, then squeezed back in deep stretch, came out and gained the show late. GRECIAN (ARG) stalked off the rail then bid alongside the pacesetter into the second turn, took a short lead in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and lost third late. SOL MI FA (IRE) chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VELVET MOONLITE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch but weakened late.
