Footnotes

EL VALENTIN sped to the lead between horses, maintained the advantage around the turn and held his foes safe to the wire. LIQUID ASSET stalked the pacesetter on the inside around the turn, angled off the wood in upper stretch to challenge the winner but had to settle for second best. GRAND MANEUVER was off slowly, recovered to move up on the backstretch, improved his position on the turn, entered the stretch four wide and rallied to gain third at the wire. DESTINED JOURNEY was off slowly and outrun to the lane, found the rail through the drive and improved his position. BOLD FRESH stalked outside around the turn and did not rally in the stretch. SI ES VERDAD pulled hard and moved up between horses to force the pace into the turn, but gave way in the stretch drive. CERTAINLY CERTAIN pressed the pace on the outside into the turn, drifted out badly on the turn and was eased in the middle of the track in the final furlong. KEITH THE MAILMAN chased from the back of the pack and failed to mount a rally.
