ADVANTAGE PLAYER had good early speed and set the pace inside, inched away on the turn and held on gamely under urging. BROWN IS BEIGE a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival then just off the rail, swung out into the stretch and closed gamely to just miss. NICE MEIDEL stalked inside then between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn, came out three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and was outfinished but bested the rest. MISS REDITORE close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SCARLET STARLET prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked just off the rail, was between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. FREE RANGE broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OUR CURIOUS KITTEN broke outward but alertly, stalked outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn, dropped back leaving the turn and also weakened.
