Footnotes

HOTSTEPPER had good early speed and dueled between horses, battled outside the runner-up in the stretch, put a head back in front under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. AEROMON dueled inside rivals but off the rail, put a head in front along the fence on the turn, fought back while drifting out in the stretch and continued gamely to the end. VOLACIOUS bobbed slightly at the start, chased between horses or outside a rival, split foes into the stretch, angled to the inside and just got the show. DETECTIVE POIROT stalked outside a rival on the backstretch then a bit off the rail, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. TRIBUNAL BLUES chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, angled in and split horses on the line. WARREN'S TOMMY TOO broke in onto a rival, settled outside, came four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. HUSKY GLORY squeezed back at the start, settled between horses, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, angled in and split foes late. DANCING YODELER stalked the pace inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. SOPHOMORIC VENTURE broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. MR. DAY TRIPPER dueled outside then three deep between horses on the turn and into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and weakened. SHIFT FOUR broke alertly then settled between horses chasing the pace, continued outside leaving the backstretch, angled in between foes on the turn and lacked a further response. SACRED GHOST hesitated to be away behind the field, angled in and moved up inside chasing the pace, continued inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch. BIG G'S DANCE chased a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes into the turn and also had little left for the drive.
