Footnotes

THE SMOKSTER, broke inward, saved ground unhurried, came out into the stretch, split rivals twice and rallied inside under urging to prove best. WALK THAT WALK, came out off heels into the first turn, moved up inside early on the second turn and three deep leaving that bend, split rivals in midstretch, angled out and finished well. TOO HIGH, between rivals early, stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid outside BAXTER PASS on the second turn, took a short lead but could not hold off the top pair. IRISHEYESAREFLYING, angled in and saved ground early, went between horses into the second turn and outside J.R. HOLMES on that bend and lacked the needed late kick. BAXTER PASS, sped to the lead and the inside, set the pace, dueled inside TOO HIGH on the second turn and to midstretch but weakened. J. R. HOLMES, outside the winner early, moved up inside into and on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. PRESTIGIOUS CHIEF, four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then outside MY ANTONINO, was four wide into the stretch and weakened. MY ANTONINO rank inside early and steadied on the first turn and again leaving that bend, came out approaching the second turn and three deep into the stretch, then also weakened. VAGUELY GALLANT, settled in midpack outside, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
