Footnotes

GALLANT CAT forced the pace outside then stalked alongside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear under urging. DUTCHESS EBEN well placed stalking the pace inside to the stretch, bid along the rail in the drive and was clearly second best. FUHRMIDABLE chased toward the inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. NITA MOON UP bobbled at the start, settled inside, was a bit crowded off heels early on the turn, came out on the bend, went around a rival in midstretch and lacked the needed response inside. BELLE OF PORTUGAL sped between horses to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, relinquished control just past the eighth pole then was being pulled up in the final sixteenth but walked off. HONEYOFASCORE between horses early, chased outside then off the rail, angled to the inside early on the turn and did not rally. SECRET CAPER chased outside then alongside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
