HOLLYWOOD STORY angled in on the first turn and chased inside, moved up three deep into and on the second turn, bid outside the runner-up and took a short lead into the stretch, drifted out in the drive but held on gamely under steady handling while being shown the whip. HEALTHY ADDICTION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back when headed, came off the rail past midstretch and continued gamely to the wire. SHARP LISA stalked the pace off the rail, was between horses early on the second turn then outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. PROPOSED bumped at the break, went four wide into the first turn then stalked outside a foe, continued off the rail into the second turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. FREAKIN STREAKIN three deep into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. BARDY WOMAN broke in and bumped a rival, angled in nearing the first turn and lagged back inside, came off the rail in the stretch and was not a threat.
