Footnotes

OUTLAW JONES sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside and drew off in the stretch under a brisk hand ride while being shown the whip. ADD HEAT stalked the pace three deep then outside on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and was clearly second best. GET OFF THE SUGAR pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the second turn, split rivals into the stretch and bested the others. WOODEN TICKET unhurried off the rail early, angled in leaving the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and improved position. SCAT THIEF stalked between horses then inside on the second turn and weakened. OLIVER TWISTED angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and did not rally. KEY MAKER stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. POINT OF IMPACT saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back into the stretch and had little left.
