LEANESSA stalked the pace a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, bid inside in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under urging. WHOOPDDOO chased outside then three deep on the backstretch, took the lead outside the pacesetter into the stretch, inched away and held on well but was worn down late. RUN RATE settled outside chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. STARSHIP SARATOGA saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HARVEST GIRL sped to the early lead outside a rival, angled in and set the pace toward the inside, fought back when challenged leaving the turn and into the stretch but weakened. CEE'S ELEGANCE threw her head a bit in the early strides, dropped back off the rail without early speed, continued off the inside and was outrun.
