Footnotes

JANEIAN (NZ) angled in and saved ground then stalked a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the stretch, came out in upper stretch, surged to the front under urging in midstretch and pulled clear. KATDOGAWN (GB) broke slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, split rivals in midstretch then angled in again and finished with interest inside. MAKEUP ARTIST came a bit off the inside into the first turn, chased just off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, went three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. SPARKLING AVA pulled a bit early, stalked off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn and took a short lead, inched away into the stretch, could not match the winner, was in a bit tight late and was outfinished for a minor award. FUN HOUSE saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch, split horses in midstretch and could not summon the necessary late response. HIPPOGATOR sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
