Footnotes

TICKER TAPE (GB) stalked the pace between foes early then outside, moved up three deep on the second turn, took the lead outside the pacesetter into the stretch, kicked clear, drifted in under urging but held gamely. DANCE IN THE MOOD (JPN) pulled her way along early, stalked inside, came out into the

stretch, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. HOLLYWOOD STORY also pulled early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, awaited room leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch and finished well for third. WESTERN HEMISPHERE wide in the chute, took the lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner into the stretch and weakened some but lost third late. AMORAMA (FR) angled in and raced unhurried inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. MAMBO SLEW chased between horses or outside a rival, split foes in the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. BOULEVARDOFDREAMS (NZ) saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into the stretch but also lacked the necessary late response. ETERNAL MELODY (NZ) off a bit slowly, settled outside, came five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. MISTY HEIGHTS (GB) pulled her way into a bit of a tight spot into the first turn, chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between foes into and on the second turn, moved up some leaving that bend but could not sustain the bid. WESTERN RANSOM close up stalking the pace outside the runner-up then between foes leaving the second turn, weakened. STEEL PRINCESS (IRE) allowed to settle outside chasing the pace, was in tight off heels into the stretch and failed to menace. LOVELY RAFAELA angled in and chased outside a rival or between foes, went three deep into the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. FRENCH LADY (NZ) between horses early, stalked outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
