ANZIYAN ROYALTY stalked the pace inside then bid along the rail, took a short lead leaving the backstretch, dueled on the second turn, kicked clear into the stretch and held under some urging and steady handling. SLEWSTON sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside the winner on the backstretch and second turn, had that one slip away into the stretch but narrowed the gap late. EL ELOGIADO (ARG) stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. MORE MODERN was in a good position stalking the pace inside to the stretch and lacked the needed response. SANKY PANKY allowed to settle off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and improved position. FONZ'S chased between horses then off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. MENUHIN (GB) settled a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and failed to menace. AMERICAN LIBERTY four wide into the first turn, chased three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back on that bend and gave way.
