Footnotes

CLASSY BAY well wide early, chased outside and five wide into the turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes to gain the lead under urging, drifted in and held gamely. BURNT between horses early, chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid between foes, also drifted in and continued willingly. IF NOT FOR YOU stalked between horses then outside foes, bid alongside a rival leaving the turn, was fanned out a bit into the stretch, gained a short lead, fought back off the rail in midstretch, then drifted in and bested the rest. ARMENIAN DANCER sped between foes to the early lead, inched away a half mile out, set the pace off the rail, fought back leaving the turn, drifted out a bit into the stretch and weakened. DREAMS

AFLEET chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed rally. CONTINENTAL DANCER broke alertly then dropped back wide between foes, continued off the rail, angled in on the turn and improved position in the stretch. WARREN'S DREAMING chased off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the necessary late kick. MME GOLDPIECE broke inward and a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail, angled in nearing the turn and failed to menace. ASK MY LAWYER chased between horses then outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SERPINESERPINE stalked between horses then four wide leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. ON VAPORS steadied in tight after the start, settled a bit off the rail and was not a threat. SERIES OF DREAMS pressed then stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened. DINNER AND A DANCE broke a bit slowly, dropped back inside without early speed and was outrun. DANCE TO MY LOU pulled her way up inside to stalk the pace, steadied sharply in tight into the turn and dropped back, steadied again into the stretch and had little left.
