BRIGAND had good early speed and dueled four wide between horses then three deep into the turn, battled outside a rival on the turn, took a short lead into the stretch, inched away under urging in deep stretch and just held. CLOUD HOPPER chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and finished well to just miss. BASMATI dueled between horses then inside on the turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened late but held third. GOT EVEN went up inside to duel for the lead, stalked on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. TALE BE TOLD broke slowly, settled inside, came out around a rival into the stretch, angled in some and lacked the needed rally. CAST A DOUBT prompted the pace five wide then stalked off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in off the fence on the turn and had little left for the stretch. SMART ELLIS settled off the pace inside, saved ground to no avail. TRUCO LATINO dueled between horses then stalked outside a rival early on the turn, bolted to the far outside midway on the turn and was pulled up.
