Footnotes

THE USUAL chased between horses then outside a rival into the turn, continued off the rail, came out in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up four wide at the wire. DEWEY'S TRICK stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the turn, then surged between horses late to just miss. MANGO ESCAPADE sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail and held on well but was caught while between foes late. ARGENTINISIMA (ARG) stalked the pace inside, was shuffled back from tight quarters into the turn, went around a rival in deep stretch and surged late inside. TREBIA (CHI) close up stalking the pace inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and could not summon the needed late response. SPINNING AT DAWN wide early, stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, continued outside a rival leaving the bend and lacked the needed rally. LADY MARQUISE (NZ) off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, continued just off the inside into the stretch and gained ground late but was not a threat. GREEN QUEEN (IRE) broke slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHEBEEN (GB) sent between horses early, dropped back a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the turn and three deep into the stretch and also lacked a rally.
