KALOOKAN LESSIE dueled between horses three deep on the backstretch, battled three wide into and on the turn and into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away, drifted in late and held gamely. SUNDAY DRESS stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and finished well. NICOLE AND BEN had good early speed and dueled between horses to the stretch, weakened but held third. HEIRLOOM ROSE chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. ALPENWALD went up inside to duel for the lead, battled along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SILBER unhurried along the inside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and failed to menace. RIO ROSIE prompted the pace four wide on the backstretch, fell back nearing the turn, angled in outside a rival on the bend and weakened. PRIZESSIN broke inward then steadied in tight early, settled outside on the backstretch and five wide into the turn, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
