SEARCHFORTHETRUTH a bit slow to begin, chased inside then off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out four wide into the stretch and rallied under some left handed urging and strong handling to get up nearing the wire. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS prompted the pace outside a rival then between horses, stalked on the turn, re-bid alongside the pacesetter past the eighth pole, gained a short lead in deep stretch and continued willingly but was edged late. MAJESTIC DIAMOND (NZ) chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, split horses in midstretch and rallied between rivals. MUTAK GOLD prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch, continued between foes and was outfinished. POCOSIN'S GAME BOY sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away again on the turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened some late. CAYAMBE angled in and chased inside, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response.
