MONTEREY JAZZ dueled outside a rival then inched away early on the backstretch, angled in and set the pace inside, opened up before going six furlongs and held on gamely under a strong hand ride. ARTISTE ROYAL (IRE) settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and picked up the place. WHATSTHESCRIP (IRE) came out leaving the chute and went three deep into the first turn, chased off the inside, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed response. GIANT GEM stalked outside a rival then chased a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. STORM MILITARY (ARG) had good early speed and dueled inside the winner then stalked that one, was outside a rival into and on the second turn, dropped back and angled to the inside in the stretch and gave way.
