Footnotes

D'PENDABLE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, drifted out a bit from the whip in the stretch and held on gamely. ROBIE THE CAT sent along three deep early then chased between horses, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, was between rivals in midstretch, ducked in sharply from right handed urging in deep stretch and held second. ASNO DEL CARAMELO stalked the pace inside then came a bit off the rail on the turn, steadied off heels a quarter mile out, angled back to the fence, steadied again when crowded by the runner-up in deep stretch and bested the others. JOBURG STAR chased three deep on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AMERICAN WILDCAT prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail, continued three wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. HE BE FIRE N ICE broke slowly, settled outside a rival then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was not a threat. GAHNZO BOB a bit slow to begin, settled off the inside, drifted out early on the turn and failed to menace. SWISS TART had speed between foes then dueled outside the winner, stalked on the turn, was between horses again leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the late stretch run between the second and third finishers but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
