Footnotes

GOOD ACKTRESS moved up between horses to take the early lead, dueled on the inside down the backstretch, shook clear in midstretch, drifted out some in the final furlong and remained clear at the wire. SOCIAL EVENT chased on the outside down the backstretch, moved closer four wide around the turn, came into the stretch three wide and rallied through the final furlong to be a clear second. WARREN'S PEACOCK broke out slightly at the start, was four wide early, pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, lost contact with the winner in midstretch and weakened through the final furlong. ALEXANDRIA MARIE was in tight between horses leaving the backstretch, was asked for run approaching the quarter pole when clear and failed to offer the necessary rally. MISSILETTE raced between horses then three deep into the turn, began to weaken on the turn and fell back through the stretch drive. BANANA CREAM PIE stalked the pace on the inside down the backstretch, remained on the wood around the turn, was under urging at the quarter pole and weakened on the inside through the final furlong.
