FIVE STAR DAY hopped a bit at the start and was a bit crowded in the opening strides, pulled his way up four wide under a hold on the backstretch, stalked outside DIABLO'S EXPRESS on the turn, then wore down WEST OF THE PECOS under strong handling. WEST OF THE PECOS, sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, fought back in the stretch but was worn down late. TALL AMERICAN, angled in a bit early and was between horses, continued three deep then off the inside and picked up the show. DIABLO'S EXPRESS, also between foes early then outside BOX BUSTER, angled to the rail to loom a threat on the turn but weakened. BOX BUSTER, saved ground not far back, came out a bit leaving the turn and had little left. ISLAND APPEAL was slow into stride and outrun off the rail early, angled to the fence on the turn and was not a threat.
