Footnotes

CAPITANO forced in some at the start, saved ground stalking the early pace, went up inside on the turn to duel for the lead, gained a short advantage in midstretch, then held on gamely while drifting out a bit under left handed urging. ATTACK ALERT stalked outside then bid between horses leaving the backstretch, dueled three deep on the turn and into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out but continued willingly outside the winner. WESTCOAST THUNDER had good early speed off the rail, dueled off the inside on the backstretch and between horses on the turn and in the stretch but weakened some late. WILD BABE stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed rally. COURAGEOUS ACT also chased a bit off the inside, split horses on the turn and could not offer the necessary late kick. THAT'S AN OUTRAGE unhurried off the inside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. DIAMOND INDY off a bit awkwardly, settled off the inside, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. PLENTY OF HEAT wide early, settled well off the rail, also angled in on the turn and was not a factor. FEB ELEVEN wide between horses early, went up three deep leaving the backstretch to duel for command, dropped back on the turn and had little left.
