Footnotes

SKY JACK dueled inside for six furlongs, inched away leaving the turn and won clear under some urging. LEGENDARY WEAVE between horses early, forced the pace outside the winner, could not match that one in the stretch but held second. ROMANCEISHOPE stalked the pace a bit off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch, continued off the inside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and bested the others. BONUS PAY DAY between horses early, stalked three deep or outside, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. YOUNGOTTAWANNA chased between horses then outside, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. LIKE A HERO off a bit slowly, settled off the inside, came four wide into the stretch and also lacked a rally. CALKINS ROAD four wide into the first turn, chased three deep on the backstretch, angled in outside a rival on the second turn and lacked a further response. GENERAL CHALLENGE off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, quickly dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
