MAGIC MISSION (GB) settled outside a rival then off the rail, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted in through the drive, bid outside and wore down the runner-up under strong handling. LITTLE TREASURE (FR) sped to the early lead, dueled inside on the backstretch and second turn, inched away again in the stretch, fought back along the rail and continued gamely to the wire. BELLESKI stalked inside but a bit off the rail, continued between horses into and on the second turn, waited a bit into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and picked up the show. CHERCHEUSE saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, continued along the rail and lacked the needed late kick. ANGEL GIFT stalked off the rail then bid outside a rival and dueled for the lead, battled between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. INNIT (IRE) threw her head in the early going, angled in and settled off the rail then inside, came out in midstretch and was not a threat. SOUTHERN OASIS pulled her way between horses to stalk the pace, was boxed in on the second turn and blocked until past midstretch and could not recover. LINDSAY JEAN rank early, stalked outside, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. POLYGREEN (FR) three deep into the first turn, stalked outside, bid three wide into and on the second turn, dropped back in the stretch and had little left.
