DIAMOND DIVA (GB) steadied early, went three deep on the first turn then stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch, bid alongside PASSIFIED in the drive, momentarily put a head in front past midstretch, then fought back under urging inside the runner-up when headed by that one and gamely prevailed. VENTURA pulled between horses early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid three deep, gained a short lead a sixteenth out but was outgamed late. LADY OF VENICE (FR) settled inside chasing the pace, swung out into the stretch and picked up the show. PASSIFIED (GB) stalked early, bid outside a rival on the backstretch and dueled for the lead, put a head in front into the stretch, fought back toward the inside in midstretch and weakened late. SUPER FREAKY saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. WAKE UP MAGGIE (IRE) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out a bit on the second turn and did not rally. LA TEE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the rail and weakened in the stretch.
