M ONE RIFLE sped to the early lead, remained clear on the turn and through the lane to post a decisive victory. VIA ZAVATA chased from the inside down the backstretch, was a clear second while not threatening the winner. D C TAPIT chased the early leaders behind a wall of horses down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and was a clear third. LOYAL SON broke a bit slowly, saved ground on the turn, and finished evenly in the lane. THE USUAL Q. T. pressed the early leader four wide down the backstretch, continued to press into the lane and weakened. JOHN ELI chased the early leader three wide, fell back into the turn and was no threat thereafter. GREELY'S GHOST trailed down the backstretch and could not improve his position in the lane. HALO'S LAW chased the early leader between horses, fell back before the turn and was without a rally.
