ROMAN COUNSEL angled in and dueled outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear under urging past midstretch and held. LUNADA BAY steadied when squeezed at the start, went up three deep to stalk the pace, continued four wide into the turn, came three wide into the stretch and was second best. KURO chased off the rail then between foes into the turn, continued outside a rival leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and held third. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME broke in and bumped a rival, chased outside, went four wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. BALTIC POINT had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and until just past midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SKY CHIEF settled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. UR TURN DUBAI stalked the pace inside, fell back a bit on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. FRANK AND THE GOAT steadied early, pulled his way along three deep then chased outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. ROOS ON THE LOOSE broke out a bit, angled in early and chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened. GILLIGAN saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a factor.
