DISTURBINGTHEPEACE went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away into the turn and drew clear in the stretch under urging. D'WILDCAT angled in and dueled three deep on the backstretch, stalked outside on the turn and into the stretch, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. MELLOW FELLOW chased between horses early then off the rail, split rivals with a move on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and just got the show. BLU AIR FORCE (IRE) broke in a bit, chased off the rail, angled in for the turn, came out in upper stretch and just missed third. GREY MEMO unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. KONA GOLD dueled between horses on the backstretch, stalked the winner off the rail into and on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and weakened. I LOVE SILVER saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and was not a threat. TOP HIT chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ELABORATE allowed to settle off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a factor.
