GOOD DAY SIR sped to the early lead, set the pace inside under a snug hold, kicked clear on the second turn and proved best under a mild hand ride. AUSSIE GIRL chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and picked up the place. PAPIER MACHE had speed outside the winner then stalked that one off the rail, angled to the inside in the stretch and bested the others. FANCY BEGINING between horses early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. DARLING KRIS stalked the winner off the rail to the stretch and gave way.
