GEORGIA'S STORM broke alertly and sped to the front, set the pace off the rail, kicked clear, then held sway under some urging and steady handling. RESPECTFUL went up inside and saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside on the turn, had the winner get away in the stretch then closed the gap some late. WHO LOVES ALEYNA sent between horses to track the winner on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the bend, came a bit off the fence in midstretch and bested the rest. MISS JEANNE CAT went up four wide on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. ROARING BLAZE unhurried off the rail early, angled in and moved up inside on the turn, came out approaching the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ILE DE FRANCE three deep early, settled off the rail, inched forward outside a rival early on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. SIPHINA stalked the winner a bit off the rail then between horses on the backstretch, dropped back into the turn and weakened.
