Footnotes

RED ALERT DAY (GB) stalked off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into and on the second turn, took the lead nearing the quarter pole, inched away under urging in the stretch and won clear. THEY CALL HIM EL three deep early, chased outside a rival then off the rail leaving the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and was second best. POWER SERIES took the early lead and set a moderate pace inside, fought back on the second turn, weakened in the stretch but held third, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. TIPPETY TAP TAP saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked a further response. INTERPATATION settled inside then outside a rival on the backstretch, continued off the inside on the second turn and did not rally. VOLCANIC ICE saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and weakened.
