**Footnotes**

GOOD FRIDAY GAL pulled her way between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter, took the lead in upper stretch, drifted out under left handed urging while inching clear past the eighth pole, and held under right handed pressure late. HOT TICKET chased inside then split horses into the backstretch, chased outside a rival, was fanned out on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. DUBAI PERFECTO broke out a bit, saved ground chasing the pace and steadied in tight on the first turn, stalked along the rail, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, was in a bit close off heels momentarily past the eighth pole, angled in and bested the others. STORMY ANNA steadied when squeezed back at the start, settled inside then outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and lacked the needed rally. BELLA GIORNATTA had good early speed and bumped with a rival into the first turn, angled in and set a pressured pace along the rail, inched away on the second turn, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. J AND S EXPRESS three deep early, angled in on the first turn and chased inside, remained along the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VERY VINTAGE bumped into the first turn, prompted the pace outside a rival, fell back leaving the second turn and weakened. SEXY MELODY stalked three deep then outside a rival, dropped back three wide on the second turn, angled in some entering the stretch and also weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of DUBAI PERFECTO against the winner for alleged interference on the first turn and again in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the winner was not responsible for the trouble on the first turn and was clear when drifting out in the stretch.
