Footnotes

ROLLERSKATES chased inside then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, cut the corner into the stretch, came out in midstretch, rallied under some urging to the lead in deep stretch and proved best. STUNNINGLY between rivals early, chased off the rail then outside, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the place. ZIPPIN E had speed five wide into the first turn, kicked clear and angled in on that turn, set the pace inside, remained clear past midstretch, could not hold off the top pair but saved the show. FIRST QUEEN (GB) allowed to settle outside a rival, swung out into the stretch and bested the others. TWODOLLARSTOWIN four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, angled in between horses into the stretch and weakened. NO KA OI stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, continued outside the winner into the stretch and also weakened. SARAH GOT EVEN saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the lane. MYSTERY BIRD angled in and settled off the pace inside, saved ground to the stretch and gave way in the drive.
