CAUGHT A FLYER had speed inside then inched away and set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back when headed outside the runner-up in the stretch and gamely prevailed under some urging and energetic handling. DANCE WITH GABLE angled in and stalked inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, put a head in front a sixteenth out and continued willingly but was outgamed. POP'SHANDS ARE HOT settled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out slightly in the stretch and was in a bit close off heels on the wire. CASUAL OBSESSION bobbled slightly at the start, had speed between horses then stalked outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and was outfinished. ALIZA'S DREAM had speed three deep then stalked three wide on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in outside a rival leaving the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
