**Footnotes**

DREAMIN N SCHEMIN stalked the pace off the rail to the stretch, took a short lead outside LUNAR SURPRISE in deep stretch and held gamely under urging. FAIR KATE, also stalked outside a rival to the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. TIMELY LADY, squeezed at the start, settled outside, went between rivals into the second turn and rallied outside in the lane. LUNAR SURPRISE, angled in on the early lead, set the pace inside to deep stretch and was outfinished. HEART'S MAGIC, angled in and pulled her way along stalking the pace, remained inside and lacked the needed late kick. CONTINENTAL LEA, came out leaving the first turn, angled in on the second turn, swung out in upper stretch and improved position. RAISE A. DAISY angled in early, split rivals nearing the second turn, was pushed out a bit on that bend and did not rally. PRESIDARIA (ARG) angled in and pulled while chasing a bit off the rail, also split horses nearing the second turn, then weakened. CEE DREAMS, went outside a rival unhurried on the backstretch, angled in for the stretch and did not rally. BOBBIN LEE settled outside, went four wide on the second turn and weakened. EXTRA GRAND saved ground and dropped back when outrun.
