Footnotes

UNLIMITED VALUE sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in a bit on a short lead on the turn, responded when the runner-up loomed in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. HOOK AND LADDER off a bit awkwardly, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out around the winner into the stretch, loomed boldly in midstretch and continued willingly but could not get by. VERY CAERLEON (IRE) a bit slow to begin, dropped back off the rail without early speed, angled in on the backstretch, rode the rail thereafter and picked up the show. JAB stalked the pace close up three deep to the stretch and weakened. QUINTON'S GOLD just behind the winner a bit off the rail early, stalked that one between horses, continued a bit off the inside leaving the turn and also weakened. HOBAR came off the rail on the backstretch when unhurried, continued off the rail and was through early.
