Footnotes

ELABORATE settled outside, moved up four wide early on the turn, continued off the inside leaving the bend and rallied under left handed urging to collar the leader inside the sixteenth pole, then pulled clear. CLIQUOT forced the pace outside LEXICON early, stalked that rival a bit off the rail, could not match the winner in the final furlong but edged the former for the place. LEXICON sped to the early lead and angled in, shook off a foe to get a clear lead, remained clear past midstretch but also could not match the winner and just lost second. YOUR HALO unhurried just off the rail, split horses into the stretch and improved position. CASEY GRIFFIN chased between horses on the backstretch and toward the inside into and on the turn and lacked the needed late response. EXPRESSIONIST settled between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, continued toward the inside and also lacked the necessary late kick. BIG JAG a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival unhurried, came out some into the stretch and did not menace. NATIONAL SAINT chased between rivals on the backstretch and most of the turn and weakened. HIGHLAND GOLD saved ground in midpack, dropped back some into the turn and weakened. LORD SMITH (GB) tracked the leaders five wide early and four wide on the backstretch, went three deep between foes into the turn but was in tight midway on the bend, then had little left.
