Footnotes

LAVA MAN close up stalking the pace outside a rival, bid alongside CONGRATS on the second turn, gained the advantage a quarter mile out, kicked clear in upper stretch and drew off under left handed urging. BORREGO settled off the pace outside a rival, advanced between horses on the second turn, went around a foe leaving that turn, found the rail in the fence and gained the place. CONGRATS sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner on the second turn, drifted out a bit in midstretch and bested the others. MUSIQUE TOUJOURS off a step slowly, chased three deep then outside on the backstretch and second turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LIMEHOUSE bobbled at the start, chased inside then a bit off the rail, came under urging leaving the backstretch, angled out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. KEEP ON PUNCHING stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. DEPUTY LAD saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a factor. ANZIYAN ROYALTY chased outside, went four deep then three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and failed to menace. PT'S GREY EAGLE well placed stalking the pace along the inside, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
