The nominated winner of the Hollywood Gold Cup will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2011 Breeders' Cup Classic, nominated winner will be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived for the Championship Race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend of \$10,000 (US) if traveling from a location in North America or \$20,000 (US) if traveling internationally. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner and trainer.

**Footnotes**

FIRST DUDE chased outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up three wide in the final stride. GAME ON DUDE had speed three deep then alongside TWIRLING CANDY early, angled in and inched away approaching the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back when challenged on the second turn and into the stretch, came a bit off the fence in the drive, regained a slim advantage a sixteenth out and continued gamely to the wire. TWIRLING CANDY tugged his way along inside then stalked from the rail nearing the first turn, came off the fence into that turn and tracked the runner-up just off the rail on the backstretch, bid between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, put a head in front in upper stretch, fought back through the final furlong and continued willingly between horses late. SETSUKO stalked the pace outside a rival, moved up on the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. AWESOME GEM saved ground chasing the pace, split horses on the second turn and into the stretch, angled back inside in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. DARK COVE angled in and settled off the pace a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came out in the stretch and did not rally. MISS MATCH (ARG) between horses early, stalked the pace along the inside to the stretch and weakened. SOUL CANDY angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked a further response.
