MIRACLE MAKER chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, lugged in some in the drive but rallied under some left handed urging to prove best. CASH IN THE BANK angled in and dueled inside, inched clear into the stretch but could not hold off the winner. CHANT FOR GOLD bumped at the start, chased between horses then outside a rival, was in a bit close off heels into the stretch, came out and gained the show. PRISON CAPER saved ground off the pace, moved up some inside on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. LITTLEBITOFZIP had good early speed and angled in, dueled outside the runner-up but weakened in the stretch. ONTHEROADAGAIN squeezed back at the start, settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. DANCES WITH CZARS hesitated to be off slowly, saved ground outrun to the stretch and was not a factor. FLYING ELVIS between foes early, angled in and chased inside but weakened in the drive. LION SPIRIT broke out and bumped a foe, stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. CAPE KENNEDY chased outside on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, was pulled up when lame in the stretch and vanned off.
