Footnotes

DISTINCTIVE AFLEET dueled between horses then outside a rival, gained the advantage leaving the turn, inched clear in the stretch and held gamely under good handling. MALIBU CANYON stalked inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch, bid inside the winner and continued willingly to the wire. LAKE MEZA pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace on the backstretch and turn, came out some into the stretch and bested the others. RUNONDEMAND had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch, then weakened. QUAKER RUN stalked three deep then between horses on the backstretch, fell back off the rail on the turn and did not rally. ELUSIVE CHIEF had speed three wide then stalked four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and weakened. GLAD TO BE ALIVE broke inward and steadied in a slow start, pulled his way along off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and was outrun.
